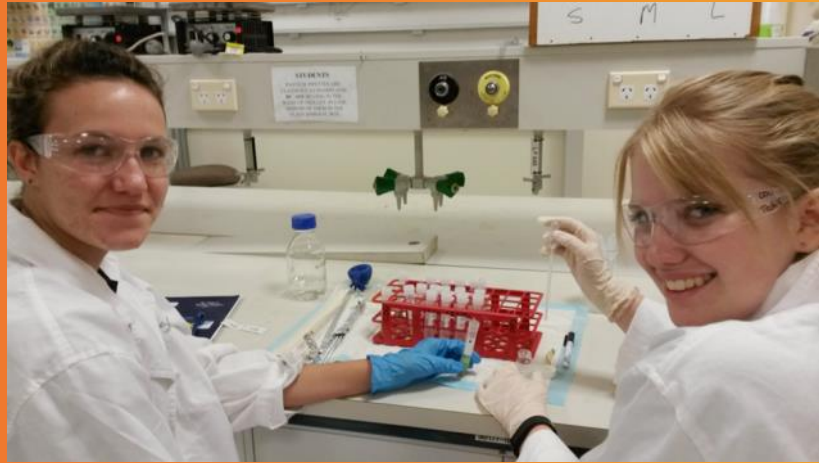

Students must achieve an **A, B or C** in **140 credits** out of 200 credits.

Students will earn credits for their studies. A total of **200 credits** are required to successfully complete the NTCET. Ten credits equates to one semester or six months of study.

Refer to the SACE Board VET Recognition Register for information about the recognition of **VETFSS in the NTCET**.

In order to gain an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (**ATAR**), students are required to successfully complete three 20 credit Stage 2 tertiary admissions subjects (**TAS**) and 30 final credits from flexible options. This could be a fourth or fifth stage 2 subject (1x20 credit, 2 x 10 credit or recognised learning).

Students must achieve an **A, B or C** (C– for Stage 2 subjects) for all the **compulsory subjects** or courses.

Every Stage 2 subject will have **30% external assessment**, which means an expert from outside the school will assess a student's work; **70%** of the subject's assessment will be made by schools and these results will be checked/**moderated** by an expert from outside the school.

Interstate and overseas students may be **granted status** for studies. Students who have completed a full Australian or overseas senior secondary program or part qualification that is considered to be the equivalent to NTCET Stage 1 will be granted status, including the Personal Learning Plan (PLP). These students will need to show that they have meet the literacy and numeracy requirements.
