## **GUIDE TO DROP OFF / PICK UP and PARKING ZONES**





The 'No Parking' sign with complementary 'Kiss & Go' Zone sign allows vehicles to stop for a sufficiently short period (less than two minutes) to set down or pick up children without leaving the vehicle.



7<sub>44</sub>-839 Tip: Sit your child in the rear passenger seat closest to the kerb with their school bag at their



The "10 minute" sign with complementary "Wait a While" **WHILE** Zone allows sufficient time for parents to accompany their children in to or out of school.



Reverse out carefully, clearing the Zone for other parents.



The "No Limit" parking sign with complementary "Stop & Chat" Zone replaces the traditional all day parking.


## STANDARD PARKING

Normal on and off street parking. Please obey all statutory road rules

The school community thanks you for your cooperation







- Allow yourself enough time to get to school and then work/home.
- Slow down and follow all traffic laws and speed limits. The school speed zone is 40kph or less from 7am to 5pm.
- Expect the unexpected. Children are still learning the rules of the road, and may not do as directed or expected. Be prepared to react.
- Pay extra attention at the zebra crossings, and if present, obey the Road Safety Officer's (Lolly Popper's) directions (on Chapman Road).
- Watch for children walking or biking, both on the road and the footpath.
- Be extra cautious in bad weather. Remember that rain reduces visibility for everyone.
- Use the rear kerbside passenger 'safety door' for your child's disembarkation. Place their school bags on the floor of this door.
- Follow our local drop off and pick up Kiss and Go system when parking.
